handy


Some markers if you want to fancy things up

SHADOWSI

Shadows are created when a light source hits a solid (opaque) object. The object stops the light from shining through, and a dark area is cast from edge of the object furthest from the light. In this case, the object is a square!









There are many ways to make shadows...let's look at a few of my faves!

But instead of starting with letters, let's start with something simple like a box.

Duplicate the box (or letter)and move it:



If you want, you can cut some rectangles out of heavy paper or cardstock and use them to trace over, then move as described, then trace again.



Let's try it on a circle


The spaces marked with an 'x' are the shadow

In this style of shadows, you are basically just duplicating the letter and moving it to the right and down. It can sometimes be confusing to know when the centers are supposed to be filled in, so i have marked them with an 'x'
